Anvil is committed to the utmost compliance with certification standards under the statutes which are applicable to its products. Anvil provides certificates to assure its customers of its compliance with CPSIA rules applicable to its products.

Under the Flammability Standard for Apparel set forth in 16 C.F.R. Part 1610, garments made of fabrics weighing more than 2.6 oz. per yd. are exempt from flammability testing. Anvil manufactures and sells blank shirts made of fabric weighing over 2.6 ounces per square yard. Therefore, Anvil blank shirts are exempt from the flammability testing.¹

The certificates are available electronically and can be accessed under the “Compliance” tab of www.anvilknitwear.com for each case or lot number.

In addition, for shirts made for children 12 years or under, other standards apply related to lead content. The lead content of the blank “youth” shirts sold by us will be certified by Anvil.

Anvil continues to provide tracking labels on children’s t-shirts which may be tracked on www.trackmyt.com.
